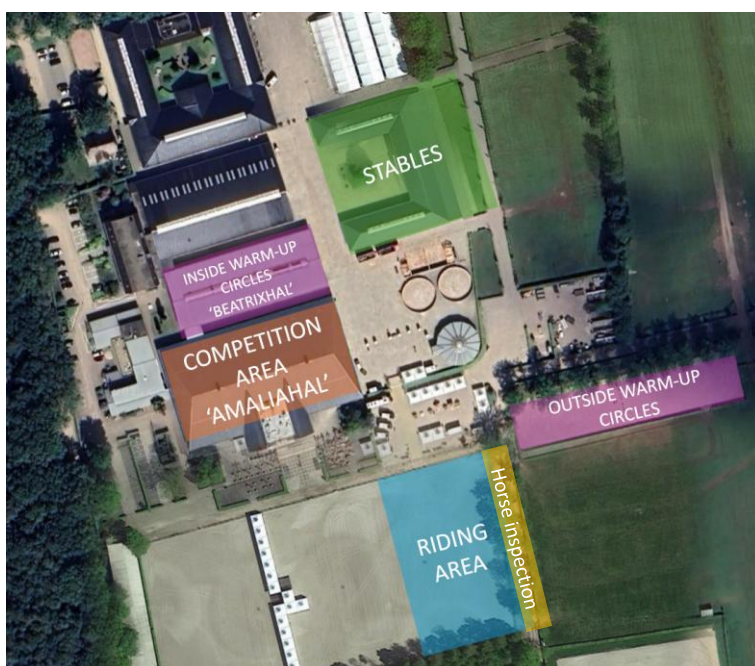


Welcome to CVI Ermelo 2026!

Just a few notes in advance to ensure a smooth-running competition. Please spread these announcements within your equipe.

- **Practice area:**
 - There are 3 warm-up circles in the 'Beatrixhal' and outside there are 5 warm-up circles in the 20x100m outdoor arena. These are marked purple in the plan below.
 - The Beatrixhal (warm-up area) is open for training on Thursday from 15.00 – 22.00. To make use of this, claim a spot on the schedule in the Beatrixhal.
 - There is an outdoor area open for riding. No reservation is required. This area is marked in blue in the plan below.
- **Competition:**
 - Warm-up circle next to competition arena in the 'Amaliahal': Because of the safety during the competition, it is only allowed to be in the warm-up arena with 1 squad/individual/Pas de Deux, 1 lungeur and 1 coach. Please leave this area immediately after competing. The Amaliahal is marked in orange below.
 - The Amaliahal can be reached through the inside warm-up area in the Beatrixhal.
- **Horse inspection:**
 The horse inspection will be on the path marked in yellow, next to the riding area.



- **Walk by hand in main arena:**
 After your horse is approved in the horse inspection, there is a possibility to walk the horse by hand in the competition arena. This is also the only time you can check your music at the music/speaker table.

- **Stables:**

The stables are open during the times listed below. Outside these times, there is always someone on the grounds in case of emergencies. Please make sure to write a mobile phone number (including the land code) on the sheet on your horse's box where the responsible person can be reached.

- Entrance to stables: You can only enter the stables with a coloured bracelet.
- Dogs are not allowed in the stables.
- Prams, pushchairs and small children are not allowed in the stables.
- It is not allowed to paste or glue anything to the stables and stable doors, please use the provided sheet on your box!
- Keep the corridors as clean & as empty as possible.
- There is no possibility to put horses outside. The treadmill will be closed.

- **Show office:**

The show office is open on Thursday from 12.30 until the end of the Chef d'Equipe meeting/draw and on competition days from an hour before the start until an hour after the end of the competition day.

Vouchers for hay, straw and shavings can be obtained at the show office. They can be redeemed for the respective goods at the stable manager's office.

- **Restaurant:**

The restaurant "Brasserie de Ruif" is open during the times listed below.

Saturday	07.30-21.30 (kitchen closes 20.00)
Sunday	07.30-19.30 (kitchen closes 19.00)

- **Hair & make-up:**

- It is not allowed to do hair and make-up inside the restaurant.
- Please don't use aerosols (like hair spray and deodorant) on the stands/bleachers during the competition.

- **Start lists and results:**

- Results and start lists are available online (www.vaultingresults.com) and will not be provided on paper.
- The start list on Sunday will be in reverse result order. Please let the show office know if double starts with the same horse will go in together or separately before the start of the YV2* on Saturday (19.30h).

- **Price giving Ceremony:**

Participation in the Prize-giving Ceremony of placed Athletes is compulsory (for each commenced 4 Squads and/or Individual Vaulters and/or the Pas-de-Deux and their Lungers with a minimum of 5 prizes). The prize-giving ceremony will **not** have the winning horses.

- *Dogs:*
Dogs need to always be on the leash outside and are NOT allowed in the competition arena (including stands/bleachers) and stables.
- *Livestream:*

- *Orange bins are for deposit bottles & cans*
Please be aware that the orange bins are solely for deposit bottles and beverage cans. We ask you to communicate to your competitors to not throw away deposit bottles/cans in other bins and to not use the orange bins for anything other than deposit bottles/cans.
- *Car parking*
Please be aware that the area marked in orange below is prohibited area. Passenger cars can park in the area marked in green.
